
## TIGER MOSQUITO BIOLOGY

- Invasive species from Asia
- The female is the one that bites to mature the eggs
- Its chopping activity is during the day
- It can transmit diseases such as dengue, zika or chikungunya





# **MARSH MOSQUITO BIOLOGY**

- One of the most common species of these environments is Aedes caspius
- They develop in flood-prone marsh areas, depending on the rainfall regime
- The grub develop all at the same time, causing an "explosive" emergence of adults
- They are very aggressive
- They are active during the day, and can fly long distances



### **HOW ARE THEY FIGHTED?**

- Carrying out biological treatments
- Bti (Bacillus thuringiensis) is very selective and only affects mosquito larvae and black fly
- Larvicidal treatments are prioritized due to their effectiveness, which prevent the development until adult stage
- Weekly actions are carried out in the areas of marsh and are reinforced after rainfall or accidental flooding



### **HOW CAN CITIZENS HELP?**

- ▶ **Keeping** your **flood-prone plots** in good condition
- Cleaning plots, so that they are free of weeds as reeds that make management and treatment difficult
- Maintaining ditches and water outlets to facilitate the evacuation of water
- Avoiding water accumulation due to excessive irrigation
- Chlorinating irrigation ponds or protecting them with 1 mm thick meshes
- Avoiding containers that can accumulate water in the outdoors
- Collaborating with city councils and the Provincial Council

# **PLACES TO AVOID WATER**

#### Avoid standing water for more than 2-3 days in a row



Avoid waterlogging in the garden



Keep ornamental fountains clean and disinfected



Cover tree holes with sand or plaster



Cover the water collection containers with mosquito nets 1mm mesh



Avoid accumulations of water on car wheels



Renew frequently the water deposited in the pot plates



Avoid accumulations of water in covers that cover swimming pools and other garden elements



Avoid accumulations of water in buckets, watering cans and containers exposed to the elements



Avoid accumulations of water on umbrella feet, rain gauges...



Empty frequently the water dish of domestic animals



Clean drains and gutters



#### SELF-PROTECTION OF THE CITIZENSHIP



Use mosquito repellents with DEET, Icaridin, IR3535 or Citriodiol on exposed skin, following the labeling instructions and/or product leaflet before application



In **babies under two months**, always **use physical barriers** such as mosquito nets to cover cribs and strollers, avoiding the use of repellents

In **babies with more than two months**, if necessary **repellents**, it is especially advisable to consult the manufacturer's and **pediatrician**'s recommendations



In the face of extraordinary situations with a high incidence of mosquitoes, avoid outdoor activities during busiest hours



In areas with a high presence of mosquitoes, equip homes with mosquito nets to prevent access to the interior



If you travel to a **foreign country where endemic diseases exist** such as dengue, zika or chikungunya,
have received bites there and **notice certain symptoms**, **go to** your **health center** and tell them
